Dear Mark

I am replying to your letter of 3 June in which you ask for comments on the PSB Corporation predegree programmes in Chemistry and Biological Chemistry.

From the material you forwarded I assess that the courses offered are significantly above the standard of TEE Chemistry in Western Australia. They would be more akin to a UK "A" Level than to our Year 12. Students who had completed and passed these two courses should be well prepared for the highest level offerings in the Chemistry Discipline in first year at The University of Western Australia. They would be missing a small amount of factual detail about WA industrial processes, but their background in theoretical and practical chemistry would be impressive.

I have some minor concerns:

*the use of so-called molecular equations is antiquated.

*the written part of the examination in Chemistry only counts for 30%. In an Australian context, the opportunity to multi-guess 70% of the paper I regard as a poor motivator. [Singapore students are however probably more conscientious than Australian students.]

* although the index listed a sample examination paper in Biological Chemistry, no sample paper was included in the file.

Overall however I have no hesitation in recommending these courses as suitable pre-requisites in lieu of WA TEE Chemistry.
